



## 2012 Australian Title Supplementary Regulations

REFER TO SPEEDWAY AUSTRALIA RULES & REGULATIONS EXTRACT BELOW

### 7.9 TECHNICAL

- 7.9.1** All race cars must comply with the specification requirements of the relevant state, national or sanctioning bodies, as amended from time to time.
- 7.9.2** If at anytime during a race meeting or during subsequent inspection after a race meeting, a race car is found to be not complying with the specification requirements the Chief Steward will issue an Infringement Notice to disqualify that car from the race meeting and, in the Chief Steward's discretion, impose a fine up to \$2,000 and/or suspension of up to two years.
- 7.9.3** Without limiting rule 7.9.2 a minimum penalty of 12 months and a maximum penalty of 24 months suspension and/or a \$2,000 fine may be imposed for any of the following:
- (a) any unauthorised person altering or person misrepresenting a Log Book;
  - (b) any person making a false log book declaration or knowingly provides information for the registration of a race car;
  - (c) the deliberate destruction of a log book
  - (d) any person misrepresenting a race car or safety apparel
  - (e) use of any engine, car or other component which offends against the published specifications
  - (f) refuses to have their engine checked
  - (g) uses traction control
  - (h) abuse of speedway property or safety equipment; or
  - (i) use of illegal fuel or additives.

### Engine Measuring

#### 4 Stroke Engines

Due to the difficulty of measuring 4 stroke engines in a timely manner at the track, it will be a requirement of this meeting for all 4 stroke engines to be "Sealed" using the approved Microsprint method and device.

Please be aware that all engines using the Tag system must have a "Engine Tag" purchased from the Club Secretary at a cost of \$15.00 each, and must be fitted by your Engine Builder only.

The "Engine Measurement Declaration Form" (as found on each states Forms page on the website) must be also filled out by the Engine Builder and the "Engine Tag" number attached to the engine must be included on the declaration form

**\*\*Please Note:**

***Unsealed 4 stroke engines will not be permitted to start the race meeting under any circumstance.***

## **2 Stroke Engines**

2 Stroke engines will be measured at the circuit on the night. The competitor will be required to make available any required tools and perform any necessary disassembly work on the motor requested by the engine measurer during the process to confirm compliance.

## **Other Supplementary Regulations**

1. Any driver not in attendance at the drivers briefing will automatically start rear of field for their first designated heat.
2. Race Receivers are mandatory.
3. Random checks will be made throughout the night for rear track width.
4. The first 4 place getters in the final must present their cars for impounding immediately at completion of the final, a designated area will be set aside for this purpose. Engine checks will be performed on the first 3 placegetters.
5. The two spinout rule will apply. All cars spinning will go to rear of field regardless of fault (the only exception will be spinning to avoid an accident. This will be at the discretion of the officials).
6. Please make available sponsor signage areas (nose cone wing centre and area on right and left sides of car or wing.)
